



TOURIST PACKAGE 3 DAYS/2 NIGHTS



MATELICA – SAN SEVERINO MARCHE – ELCITO – CANFAITO – FABRIANO

Day
1

Arrive in Matelica, center of picena origin in which have been recently found the necropolis in the municipal territory, then develops as a Roman municipium in the I century d. C., bishop's seat since the fifth century and subsequently submitted to the Duchy of Spoleto and the Signoria degli Ottoni until 1578. Its territory, for the position and for its climate, is renowned for the production of Verdicchio, white wine doc. Tasting of local meats and cheeses at the foyer of Teatro Piermarini, with the possibility to visit the Theatre and the Roman Baths. Transfer to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

Day
2

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to San Severino Marche, center of great, artistic and historical interest, probably arose after the destruction of the ancient Roman city of Septempeda of which remain remains in locality Pieve. The area of Castello al Monte,

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with the Duomo Vecchio, the Torre degli Smeducci, symbol of the Lordship that dominated San Severino Marche until 1426, and the ancient Episcopo, one of the most evocative areas of the city, from which you can admire a remarkable panorama. Free lunch. Continue to the charming village of Elcito, also called “The small Tibet of the Marche”, in fact it rises on a rock spur, place at over 820 meters above sea level. Stood just like it used to be, Elcito will make us take a dip in the past. In its central core there are stone houses, recently restored, and the remains of an ancient medieval castle, erected to defend the nearby Abbey of Santa Maria in Vallefucina. Not far from here there is the vast plateau of Canfaieto (1,100 m.) with its centuries-old beech woods. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 3

Breakfast at the hotel, departure for Fabriano, Unesco Creative City. Visit the old town starting from the Duomo (rebuilt in 1617 and dedicated to San Venanzo) the Pojo, the Gentile Theatre, the Oratory of Charity, Sant'Onofrio and the Crypt of San Romualdo. Typical lunch in restaurant. Then visit to the Paper and Watermark Museum in which are illustrated the historical phases of handmade paper. End of services.
