



**TOURIST PACKAGE 3 DAYS/2 NIGHTS** 



MATELICA, SAN SEVERINO MARCHE, ELCITO, CANFAITO, SERRA PETRONA

Day • Arrival in Matelica and visit to "Enoteca Comunale" and Piermarini theatre. Its structure is in stages: three orders and the gallery; the theatre has an elegant appearance. Wine-tasting and cold cuts in typical cellars where the famous Verdicchio is produced. In the evening move to Fabriano, hotel accommodation, dinner and overnight.

Day

Breakfast at the hotel and move to San Severino Marche, an historical and artistic centre of large interest built probably after the destruction of Septempeda, an ancient Roman city, today the remains are in Pieve. The area of "Castello al Monte" with "Duomo Vecchio", "Torre degli Smeducci" symbol of Signoria that until 1426 dominated San Severino Marche and the ancient "Episcopio" is one of the most evocative areas of the city, from which it is possible to admire an impressive panorama. Free lunch and visit of Elcito, also known as The small Tibet of Marche, in fact, it stands

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on a rock spur, over 820 meters above sea level. Left just like it was used to be, Elcito will take visitors back in time. In the centre the stone houses, recently renovated made space around the remains of an ancient medieval castle, once erected to defend the nearby Abbey of Santa Maria in Vallefucina. Not far away, there is the vast highland of Canfaito (1.100 m.) with its centuries old beech woods. Return to the hotel for dinner and accomodation.

Day 3 Breakfast at the hotel, move to the lovely medieval village of Serrapetrona, famous for the Vernaccia a particular DOCG sparkling red wine, an excellence of Marche's wines. Every year takes place the event "Appassimenti Aperti" to celebrate the autochthonous grape "Vernaccia Nera". The producers, will be with their stands in the square of the village, a festive and characteristic meeting place with music, markets and zero kilometer gastronomic delicacies. Every year this event is repeated: visitors can see the drying rooms full of bunches, and hear stories that tell of an ancient art of winemaking, a village that is covered with autumn colors and intense aromas of fine wines. During the event tourist can visit the exhibition "Fossili, il passato ritrovato". Worth visiting is also the Church of San Francesco that houses the "Crocifissione" (by Anonimo Marchigiano, dated 1180) and the polyptych executed by Lorenzo d'Alessandro at the end of the 15th century. During "Appassimenti Aperti" will be possible to visit the Church of Santa Maria in Piazza, reopened in 2018 after the restoration works. Free lunch. End of services.
